## Assistive Technology Policy

Where recommended by an appropriate report, the school will make an application to the Department of Education via the Special Education Needs Officer. (SENO).

If the application is successful, the school will purchase the relevant assistive technology.

# <u>Laptops</u>

Laptops are used solely in school and are not brought home after school or during the holidays. On leaving Wicklow Educate Together, the school signs over the laptop to the new school.

Usage of laptops is subject to all other policies of Wicklow Educate Together, including the Code of Positive Behaviour and the Acceptable Use Policy.

Where a child has a laptop, the laptop will have wi-fi functionality but will not have network access.

#### Classroom use:

- The laptop is used to assist the child's learning in school and is used as necessary throughout the school day.
- Where possible, a laptop bag is purchased with the laptop. At the end of the day, the laptop is stored in the bag and given to the class teacher to store securely in a locked cabinet.
- When walking around the room with the laptop, the laptop is closed to protect the screen.

## Support classroom use

Children are taught to type in the support room setting.

Laptops are closed when being carried between classrooms.
