History Wicklow Educate Together National School was established in 2003 and is under the patronage

of Educate Together. During the early years of the school an aftercare service was provided for one

hour per day. In 2017 a full programme of after school extracurricular activities was established,

including an after school homework club. Since then the facility has extended to remain open for

interested pupils until 5.30pm. The entire after care service running from 1.30-5.30 now caters for

almost 100 pupils per day.

Forward Plan From September 2019 the facility will run from 1.30pm to 6pm daily, we are also

considering an early start club running before school each morning. We are moving towards an online

payment solution for parents which will streamline our registration and billing procedures.

Hours of opening

1.30pm – 2.30pm Junior/Senior Infants snack time, indoor play & story time

2.30pm – 3.30pm

Junior/Senior Infants outdoor play

1st – 6th class supervised homework club or extra-curricular activity if registered

3.30pm – 4.00pm Afternoon snack in the hall for Junior Infants – 6th class. Please remember to

send in an extra snack in schoolbags.

4.00pm onwards Outdoor games & activities (weather permitting), relaxing reading & chill area,

arts and crafts, board games, Lego & toys. Please note, our aftercare facility is a technology free

zone.

Specific Days - To register a child to attend aftercare on one or more specific days every week, the

registration form must be completed, and then returned to the school office.

Ad Hoc attendance - To utilise aftercare on an ad hoc basis the same form must be completed and returned with the "ad hoc" box ticked. The school requires 24-hour notice for any ad hoc attendance

to ensure we have availability on the day.

Cost per hour is €5.00 per child per hour or part thereof. Payment is due on the first Monday of the month for the days attended in the previous month. Currently parents receive an email notification of

fees due.

Eligibility As with all our extra-curricular activities, our aftercare facility is only open to children

attending Wicklow Educate Together N.S.
